RICHARD STRUCKER Obituary



Richard A. Strucker NEWTOWN, PA Richard A. Strucker of Pennswood Village, Newtown, PA, died peacefully on Sunday, Feb. 21, 2016. He was 89.

Born in Trenton, NJ, son of the late John and Mary Strucker, he lived in Yardley, PA, for over 44 years, and resided at Pennswood Village since 2003.

Mr. Strucker was an insurance claims supervisor with New Jersey Manufacturers for 33 years, retiring in 1989.

He graduated from Trenton Catholic High School in 1947, Trenton State Teachers College in 1951, and received his master's in education from University of Indiana in 1952.

Mr. Strucker proudly served in the U.S. Merchant Marine at the end of the World War II in active duty on supply ships, visiting ports of call around the world, from Egypt to the Philippines.

Richard was the husband of the late Jean Donnelly Strucker (deceased 1986) and father of the late David B. Strucker (deceased 1961). He is survived by his son and daughter-in-law, Richard E. and Maggie Strucker of Solebury, PA, and his daughter, Jan Strucker of Arlington, VA.
